Northumberland Family Health Team (NFHT) is a not for profit organization that provides inter-professional primary health care to over 26,000 patients in west Northumberland. Our team includes family physicians, nurse practitioners, a pharmacist, registered nurses, social workers, dieticians, a physiotherapist, a chiropractor and other professionals working together to provide patient centred care. We develop and implement programs and services based on a strategic review of the health care needs of the patients and the community. We are funded by the Ministry of Health, a partner of the Ontario Health Team of Northumberland and are affiliated with three local Primary Care Clinics- Cobourg Medical Centre, Cobourg Clinic and Cobourg Health Centre.
